LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF A LIVE TRAP

- I, the undersigned, accept responsibility for the use and return of a Heart of the Valley live trap, according to the conditions listed below:
 - 1. Any animal caught in the trap must be returned to the Heart of the Valley. If the animal is wildlife (i.e. skunks, bats, raccoons) it must be released into a suitable area or brought back to the shelter.
 - 2. If in any case the animal has bitten, it needs to be euthanized or quarantined for 10 days. If euthanized, the animal needs to be taken to the diagnostic lab for a rabies testing.
 - 3. The trap can only be baited with non-poisonous food.
 - 4. The trap must be placed on the property of the borrower.
 - 5. The trap must be checked every 8 hours or less to prevent inhumane confinement.
 - 6. Heart of the Valley is not responsible for pick up or transport of the animal.

A \$50 DEPOSIT must be paid to the Heart of the Valley at the time of arrangement. Failure to return the carrier on time or return of a damaged carrier will result in forfeit of the deposit. The \$50.00 deposit will be returned in full if the above conditions are met.

<u>A rental fee of \$10 for a 7 day use</u> must be paid to the shelter at the time of the return, unless other arrangements have been made by a staff member.
